Guidelines for Hosting Area I Championships

Any event in Area 1 who is interested in hosting a Championship should review the guidelines below. Organizers are encouraged to support our Area's competitors by hosting a Championship on a rotating basis. This outline should be used as a guide to expectations. Please contact the Area Chairperson or Championship Coordinator with questions.

- A.) Event should possess the following qualities:
 - Event should take place in late summer or early fall*
 - Have ample parking for increased numbers
 - On grounds stabling preferred
 - Meet scheduling demands of traditional format (D, XC, SJ)
 - Provide awards ceremony and preferably a victory gallop
 - Accommodate additional entries
 - Provide championship level XC and SJ courses and the more difficult dressage test

B.) Application Process

- Must notify the Championship Coordinator of the event's interest in hosting
- Deadline for notice is November 1
- Sites will be determined by Area Council; and by reference to the previous year's Evaluation Forms
- The host sites will be announced annually at the Area 1 Meeting
- C.) Area will provide the following for hosting
 - \$500 for ribbons, prizes, decorations
 - Consulting from Area Council

^{*} Events that run in early summer are eligible for hosting, but need to be planned in advanced in order to extend qualifying period.
